## Cindy Wu's Interview Policy

After thoroughly reading the Cindy Wu's piano policy, all prospective students and their parent/s must attend an initial interview/piano lesson in the studio that last a minimum of a half hour to an hour. I charged a nonrefundable fee of \$25, due at the time of the interview and the application. I made the mood of the interview very relaxed and encouraging, never intimidating. The interview is an opportunity to give the student a piano lesson while getting to know the student's learning-style and background. It is also a time to see if the parent/s have the same "piano-goals" in common with my teaching, and the parents will sit down to listen and watch when the child practices at home.

I make sure the parents agree to the list of Parents' Responsibilities in the Studio Policy. Most of all, the student must respect instructor with good manners and good listening skills. I am willingly to accept any transfer students from other teachers, with the understanding that I am a very thorough teacher.

I teach all ages and all levels from beginning kindergarteners through advanced pianists. I am a firm believer that piano studies can create simultaneous mental concentration on the physical, aural, visual, and analytical aspects of reading and playing piano music. I am also a firm believer that the commitment is the key to the successful learning process. Thus, upon the interview, I shall decide whether to/not to accept the prospective students
